

## Carol Doak's Y2K Quilt



Make a quilt with five of these four-block units across and down and you will have a 2,000 piece quilt.

## Fabric Cutting List for One Block:

## For background blacks and navy:

cut 3 squares, each 3 " x 3 " and cut once diagonally for \#'s 11, $12,15,16,18$, and 20.
cut 2 squares, each 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" and cut once diagonally for \#'s $3,4,7$, and 8.
For the colored fabrics:
cut 10 strips each $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for the remaining numbers.


Each quarter block is 6". The four-rotation units are 12". Five rows of five units of each four-block rotations.

The borders are $9^{\prime \prime}$ wide finished
The finished size of the quilt is $78^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{\prime \prime}$.
